Objectives:

The network provides a platform for interested institutions and individuals in traditional Water Use worldwide. The focus is particularly on:

- Traditional irrigation
- Traditional use of springs and spring galleries
- Traditional use of water power, water works
- Historical fountains





After a phase of decline in traditional irrigation schemes in the past Century many initiatives for restoration and rehabilitation have started after 1980. Often springs and spring galleries are closely connected to irrigation. Recently many initiatives are ongoing. The platform enables the exchange of experience and knowledge and promotes synergies between the single actors.
